## Retrieval practice for GCSE geography

### Some hints and tips for revising in Geography:

- When revising separate your notes into physical and human geography
- You may want to create flashcards, mind maps to consolidate your learning
- Answering practice questions and getting feedback on these
- Reading over a case study taking in the facts and figures, then cover this up and write down on a piece of paper the facts and figures you can remember in one colour and then in another colour go back and add the facts you could not remember
- Have flashcards with the key term on one side and then the definition on the other – You can then practice these yourself or get someone else to test you. Can also do these for the command words so you are clear on what they will be asking in the exam.
- Use the Zig-Zag mind maps for each topic which have been given by your teachers – these will have all the topics and case studies on that you have studied.
- Test yourself through quizzes on the websites provided.
- Use revision wheels you have created over the last couple of years. Use a blank one to write down what you can remember in one colour and then look back over your filled in one to add in anything you could not remember in another colour
- Know and understand your fieldwork!

Closer to February half term students will receive a revision pack which will include:

- Case study booklets (these will have **all** your case studies with notes and activities to complete)
- A variety of practice questions for all three papers with hints and tips on how to answer these.
- RAG sheets to highlight what you know and what you need to revise over
