Re: Year 11 Revision Sessions and Examinations

Intervention Sessions:

In order to support students to achieve their maximum potential, intervention sessions have been put in place throughout the day which focus on Controlled Assessments, exam skills and revision. Each student has been carefully considered for each session, so they are supported with specific areas of improvement. Sessions take place in tutor time, lunch time or after school. The after-school sessions run from 3pm until 4pm.

Registers will be taken and monitored, and students will be expected to get into the habit of this extra learning time. It should not be treated as an optional extra, but rather a necessary and crucial part of their learning. We would really appreciate your assistance in ensuring that the students are aware of our expectations at these sessions. A timetable of the sessions available to all students is included.

Revision Sessions:

Attached are details of revision sessions that will be scheduled during the Easter holidays to support preparations for examinations. It is vital that all students attend these sessions. Please remind your child of these. These details have been shared with your child.

Please ensure that you and they are aware of when they need to be in school for the summer examinations (see schedule on final page). We have revised some of the school day for revision sessions from May, to allow students more time to prepare with their subject teachers.

- Students need to attend the Breakfast / Period 3 Revision / Period 5 Revision sessions if they study that subject.
- Students need to attend yellow examinations if they study that subject.
- Students need to be in usual lessons if they are not in a revision session or examination.
- All students must be in uniform.

Coursework:

We are approaching the deadlines for coursework to the exam boards. This is a non-negotiable date set by the boards for all schools in the country. Staff need to mark and check all paperwork to meet this deadline, so will be asking for coursework to be submitted by Easter. Please ensure your child is aware of any deadlines for coursework and attends any interventions to complete this, so they can meet this deadline. This will then allow them to concentrate on examinations after the holiday. If you require any more information about the coursework to support your child, please do not hesitate to contact their teacher.

Examinations:

The timetable for the summer examinations is attached. All students will need to be in school **all day in school uniform** until Monday 15th June. This is the date of their Physics examination (morning).

After this date, students will only need to be in school for revision sessions and examinations that remain. Again, they need to be school uniform for these.

It is the students' responsibility to check the date and time of their exams from their individual exam timetable. Students need to be in school by 8:30am each day. However, to support them, please ensure you are aware of these dates and times too. All examinations details, including seating, can be seen on the Examinations tab in Bromcom. Details of the revision sessions for the examinations will be shared with the reports at the end of this term.

Examinations must not be missed unless there is an exceptional circumstance (e.g. hospitalisation). It costs on average £50 to enter students per subject, but this can be more for BTEC subjects or ones with multiple examinations. Should a student miss an exam without a valid reason (e.g. hospital discharge papers), we will ask you to pay the costs of that particular exam.

In the case of extreme illness, please ring the school immediately on 01780 761000 and leave a message. Please then obtain a medical certificate and send this to the school as soon as possible. Exam boards may award a grade, if only part of an exam or one from several for a series are missed, provided a medical certificate is supplied for these exceptional circumstances. However, nothing will be awarded for students who miss examinations for common illnesses.

Please do not book holidays during the examination series, as they cannot be rearranged and students will not be awarded any marks if missed for this reason. Please try to avoid holidays in half term too, as revision sessions will be provided by staff to support with revision for those examinations in June.

Prom:

Attendance at the Prom is dependent on students meeting our expectations throughout the year. This includes attending school regularly and arriving on time, taking part in any interventions scheduled for them, completing all examinations, and demonstrating consistently positive behaviour in lessons and around the school. The Prom is a reward for students who uphold these standards, and attendance is earned through conduct and commitment—not through payment alone.

Results Day:

This year the results day for GCSE examinations is Thursday, 20th August 2026 when students may come to school to collect a school printout of their results between 9:00 am and 12:00 pm. Exam results are issued on this date and the documentation issued must be kept safely until the certificates are issued to school in November 2026. If a student cannot attend school to collect their results in person, please let us know asap.

Thank you for your support during this exam season and we look forward to many successes in the summer.
