

**Target Grade**

A target grade for future examinations based on primary school results, assessments at Stamford Welland Academy and teacher observations. This is the grade students are expected and challenged to achieve by the end of Year 11. This grade is reviewed constantly to ensure that students reach their potential.

**Current Predicted Grade**

This is the grade that the student is predicted to achieve at the end of Year 11 based on the student's performance in a subject. Fine grades are given to provide additional information to students and their families about where additional work or support is needed. To avoid confusion, the fine grade is placed in brackets after the GCSE grade.

1 –SECURE - this grade can be achieved and with additional work and support may achieve the next grade

2 – LIKELY - this grade can be achieved provided that the work and support continues to be in place

3 – VULNERABLE - this grade could be achieved if further work and support is put in place, but could slide to the next lower grade without this

**Attitude to Learning**

Always - Your teacher has identified that you show aspiration or resilience all of the time

Mostly - Your teacher has identified that you often show aspiration or resilience in lessons most of the time

Sometimes - Your teacher has identified that you are beginning to show aspiration or resilience in some of the lesson time

Not yet - Your teacher has identified that you are not showing aspiration or resilience in your learning
