We are delighted to inform you that Year 8 students will be attending the *National Holocaust Museum, Newark* on Thursday, **2nd April**. This is part of the Pledges programme and specifically focuses on the Diversity Pledge.

Students will participate in workshops run by the experts at the museum. By the end of the visit, they will have had opportunity to:

- Learn about the Holocaust and why it happened through objects,
- Access the Holocaust exhibition.
- Listen to survivor testimony.
- Think critically about individual and societal responsibility as well as considering modern challenges such as online hatred and conspiracy theories.

Key Details:

- **Date: Thursday, 2nd April 2026**
- **Venue: National Holocaust Museum, Newark, NG22 0PA**
- **Cost: There is no charge for this trip.**
- **Travel: Students will travel to and from the theatre with their teachers via coach.**
- **Timings: The coaches will leave promptly at 08:45 am so all students need to be on the school site by 08:30am.**

We will return to school by approximately 4 p.m.

A bus will also travel to Wittering arriving at approximately 4.20 p.m.

What to Bring: Students should bring a packed snack & water bottle.
(A packed lunch will be available for those students who are eligible.)

Medical information: Please ensure that the school has the up to date medical information for your child and they have any key medication with them for the trip, such as inhalers, Epi Pens. Medication can be handed in to staff on the morning of the visit if required
