<p>Read a book, at least 60,000 words and discuss with your child.</p>	<p>Take part in an ambassadorial activity outside school such as helper or leaders in a local community/sporting /cultural group</p>	<p>Take part in a holiday/weekend activity where your skill and or knowledge has deepened in a particular area.</p>	<p>Take your child to a place of significant cultural interest: museum, theatre, arts festivals, poetry reading, art gallery and other places of cultural interest.</p>	<p>Help the school in an ambassadorial capacity, or promoting the school by some other means including supporting school initiatives on social media</p>	<p>Reduce, reuse, recycle by donating to a charity shop/school of old books/games/uniform/ toys</p>	<p>Take part in a service activity for at least one term with your child</p>
