Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Year 11

The second set of mock exams are now finished. Teachers are marking their papers, and the final progress **report** will be uploaded to My Child at School in the first week back after Easter. This report will give you a sense of how well your child is preparing for their final exams. Teachers will use this information to identify key areas to work on in revision lessons.

Timeline

There are not many weeks of normal lessons left. I have included a table here that shows some of the key things that are happening in the coming weeks. You will see that exams start fairly soon after the Easter holidays. I will share a clear calendar of all of the exams with you and the students very soon. They will also get a detailed revision booklet to help them (like they did for the mocks); this is just being finalised by departments.

You will see that “normal lesson timetable” ends on Friday 8th May. After that we move to a reduced timetable of exams, **masterclasses** and independent study time, which they will be able to do at school or at home. We are finalising this timetable and will share it with you and students at the Exam Information Evening on Thursday 26th March.

I appreciate that students have just finished their mock exams and might be feeling a bit tired, but tomorrow's **V&E Day** is a key day in the calendar. We have arranged guest speakers to come in and to run additional workshops for students throughout the day alongside small group revision sessions for English, Maths, Science and Languages that focus on key areas of weakness from the mock exams and student voice.


Behaviour


Communication
