# Summer Task:

## Task 1:

Create a mind map of ideas to help you start your Personal Investigation (CW portfolio). You can begin from a single starting point and work out or use a range of starting points. The more you move away from your initial starting point the more ideas you are likely to generate and the more varied these will be. Art is a visual subject so you can add to you mind map with sketches / illustrations. Quotes, sayings, song lyrics, slogans etc can all make good starting points or spark ideas. What are you interested in? What excites you?



## Task 2:


Create a pinterest board, mood board, pages in a sketchbook of source images and artists work on the themes you have explored on your mind map. These could include images to draw from or pictures to take inspiration from (style, media, techniques, graphics etc). As well as a pinterest board start a sketchbook / scrap book. Something physical you can stick images into and write your notes / thoughts onto.



### Task 3:



In your sketchbook start to add drawings / paintings / photographs that related to your theme (AO3). These can be in any media. (Produce at least 5 good quality drawings, you can do more). Produce some artists research notes / pages in your sketchbook (AO1). These should be on artists you think are interesting and will help inspire your project. Just like at GCSE think about how you present them, how can you make the presentation relevant / effective? (Aim for at least 3 artists research double pages). In addition, you can do some little media experiments and tests for ideas (AO2). Use the pinterest board to help you.



# Success Criteria:

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## Task 1:

- The more you move away from your initial starting point the more ideas you are likely to generate and the more varied these will be. Art is a visual subject so you can add to your mind map with sketches / illustrations. 
- Push yourself to think outside the box and come up with really unusual concepts / starting points. Make it personal. Really consider presentation and use the pinterest board to help with this. Add some drawings in styles that you like or think will suit it. You could collage in images too.

## Task 2:

- The pinterest board needs to contain at least 100 images. These can include the work of artists, visual references for drawing, collage material and other inspirational images or quotes 
- With the pages collaged in your sketchbook use these as starting points for drawings and or media tests or add detailed notes on your own thoughts around them. You could try combining an image with a quote or saying etc.

## Task 3:

- Aim for at least 5 good quality drawings / paintings / photographs. The more you do the better. 
- At least 3 artists researches. Consider presentation carefully and think about the quality of your responses.
- You could add text or sayings to your drawings to give them context or extra meaning. You could annotate around the drawing with your own thoughts on it.
- With the artists research try to respond to the artists work. A copy of one of their pieces or even better something in their style / inspired by their work. Try to do more than one response and try to use more than one media or combination of.
