BookTrust research shows that reading regularly boosts wellbeing, inspires creativity, sparks imagination and encourages great conversations. Each pupil in year 7 will be introduced to 16 exciting book titles. Students will have time to look at, discuss and choose a book, which will be then ordered from BookTrust to be delivered in December. They will be then able to keep and enjoy this book completely free of charge!

Here's how you can get involved at home:

1. Talk about their book: talking about books helps build confidence and a love of reading. Ask your child why they chose their book? Who is their favourite character? What do they like most about the book?
