- **This includes homework, preparation, wider reading and super-curricular activities designed to enhance future opportunities in higher education, employment, or professional sport**

The football element of the programme includes:

- **Two professional training sessions per week**
- **Gym-based strength and conditioning sessions**
- **Performance Analysis sessions**
