Dear Year 11 Student,

The exam season is almost upon us, and I would like to clarify how the final few weeks work to ensure you have as settled experience as possible. You will shortly receive a personalised exam timetable for the entire exam period, and we have also published the full exam timetable in the Parents' section of the school website. A printed copy of the exam timetable will also be available in each Year 11 tutor group room from Tuesday 5th May.

The first day of written exams is **Friday 8th May**. From this date, you are expected to attend normal timetabled lessons unless you have an exam. For morning exams, you are expected to line up in the hall at **8.35am** for an expected **9am start** and line up at **1.15pm** for exams starting in the afternoon, with an expected **1.30pm start**. The exam boards set the length of time of each exam, and some may end **after 3pm**, so please do ensure you check the finish time for the public examinations. In school, up to and including all of your exams you **must** attend **dressed in full school uniform to include shoes, blazer and tie**. Should you miss an exam due to illness then a medical note from your doctor will be required – missing an exam without fair reason will result in you being awarded 0 marks for that part of the course.

The masterclass timetable begins on **Wednesday 6th May**, where you are expected to attend any Masterclasses, Pre-Exam Breakfast Sessions listed and all timetabled lessons. To clarify, you will either be in your exams, masterclasses or timetabled lessons until **Friday 22nd May**. When not in a morning exam you should go to tutor time as usual. Please note Session 6 revision sessions are scheduled as part of the exam preparation support and you are **strongly advised to attend**. When your exam has finished, you are expected to return to your timetabled lessons **immediately**.

The Leavers' Assembly takes place on **Friday 22nd May** from 11.20pm to 1pm in the hall and covered area. This is a lovely event and an opportunity for you to reflect on and celebrate your time at The Ferrers School. **You are required to wear full school uniform to this event.**

Following May Half Term, you will be required to attend school as follows:

- (1) To complete an **Exam**.
- (2) Attend a **Pre-Exam Breakfast**.
- (3) Attend **lessons** for subjects as per the masterclass timetable schedule in the subjects you still have exams to complete (those highlighted in blue).

You are not required to attend school at times where you do not have a compulsory commitment as outlined above. Should you wish to remain in school to revise, a quiet space in which to complete your studies will be available in the Learning Resource Centre (LRC) or the sixth form centre if you have a lanyard. You **must sign in at reception** when you are in school to complete personal revision.

The final GCSE exam is on **Tuesday 16th June**. It is important to note that the exam boards do have a 'Contingency Day' put aside on **Wednesday 24th June**. This means that you must be available to sit exams from the date of your first exam until Wednesday 24th June 2026, this is in case there is any issue with any exam paper so an alternative paper can be scheduled. It is unlikely this day will be required but you should keep this day available until you have finished your last exam.

- (3) Exam regulations – Candidate Information on page 11. **Please read this in full and ensure that you follow all expectations.**
- (4) A list of equipment that you **must** bring to all exams on page 12.

We look forward to seeing those invited to celebrate their achievements throughout their time at The Ferrers School. We do anticipate most of our students will achieve this however we are also keen to set a threshold for those students who do the right thing most of the time. The cost of tickets will be approximately £40. We know that students will be very keen to attend, but invitations will not be fully secured until all exams have been completed by **Tuesday 16th June 2026**.

A. Regulations – Make sure you understand the rules

- 1 Be on time for all your exams. If you are late, your work might not be accepted.
- 2 **Do not** become involved in any unfair or dishonest practice during the exam.
- 3 If you try to cheat, or break the rules in any way, you could be disqualified from all your subjects.
- 4 You **must not** take into the exam room:
 - (a) notes;
 - (b) an iPod, a mobile phone, a MP3/4 player or similar device, a watch, AirPods or earphones/earbuds.Any pencil cases taken into the exam room **must** be see-through.
Remember: possession of unauthorised material is breaking the rules, even if you do not intend to use it, and you will be subject to penalty and possible disqualification.
- 5 If you have a watch, the invigilator will ask you to hand it to them.
- 6 **Do not** use correcting pens, fluid or tape, erasable pens, highlighters or gel pens in your answers.
- 7 **Do not** talk to or try to communicate with, or disturb other candidates once the exam has started.
- 8 You **must not** write inappropriate, obscene or offensive material.
- 9 If you leave the exam room unaccompanied by an invigilator before the exam has finished, you **will not** be allowed to return.
- 10 **Do not** borrow anything from another candidate during the exam.

B. Information – Make sure you attend your exams and bring what you need

- 1 Know the dates and times of all your exams. Arrive at least ten minutes before the start of each exam.
- 2 If you arrive late for an exam, report to the invigilator running the exam.
- 3 If you arrive more than one hour after the published starting time for the exam, you may not be allowed to take it.
- 4 Only take into the exam room the pens, pencils, erasers and any other equipment which you need for the exam.
- 5 You **must** write clearly and in black ink. Coloured pencils or inks may only be used for diagrams, maps, charts, etc. unless the instructions printed on the front of the question paper state otherwise.
