Dear Parents and Carers,

The exam season is well underway so I would like to clarify how the final few weeks work to ensure your child has as settled experience as possible.

Student's last full day in school is **Friday 22nd May** with the **Leavers' Assembly** taking place from 11.20am to 12pm with **shirt signing**, hoodies (where purchased) and **ice cream** in the canteen and covered area afterwards. Students should attend in full school uniform and bring their shirt to be signed separately (not to be worn). Students will leave site by 1pm.

Following May Half Term, students will be required to attend school as follows:

1. To complete an **Exam**.
2. Attend a **Pre-Exam Breakfast**.
3. Attend **masterclass lessons** for subjects as per the masterclass timetable (those highlighted in blue in the masterclass document).

Students are not required to attend school at times where they don't have a compulsory commitment as outlined above. Should they wish to remain in school to revise, a quiet space in which to complete their studies will be available in the Learning Resource Centre (LRC) or the sixth form centre if they have a lanyard. Students **must sign in at reception** when they are in school to complete personal revision.

The final GCSE exam is on **Tuesday 16th June**. It is important to note that the exam boards do have a 'Contingency Day' put aside on **Wednesday 24th June**. This means that they must be available to sit exams from the date of their first exam until Wednesday 24th June 2026, this is in case there is any issue with any exam paper so an alternative paper can be scheduled. It is unlikely this day will be required but they should keep this day available until they have finished their last exam.

The Year 11 Prom is by invitation only at **The Stanwick Hotel** on **Thursday 18th June** for students who have been invited by their Senior Tutor for consistently meeting The Ferrers Framework expectations throughout year 11. We look forward to seeing those invited to celebrate their achievements throughout their time at The Ferrers School. We know that students will be very keen to attend, but invitations will not be fully secured until all exams have been completed by **Tuesday 16th June 2026**.
