Year 13 Progress Review Point 1 (PR1)

Dear Parent or Carer,

I am pleased to inform you that the first Progress Review (PR1) for your child is now available to view on Bromcom. Students will now review their outcomes in line with their planned next steps and set targets for improvement with their tutors. Tutors will share these targets and any agreed actions with you.

End of Course Predictions

The report contains a 'End of Course Prediction' (ECP) for students in each of their subjects, alongside their pride and independence grades. The ECP is the professional prediction made by your child's teacher based on all the evidence they have about your child's projected attainment. This will include, but is not limited to, work done in class and at home and attainment and progress in tests and assessments, including the end of Year 12 assessments taken before the summer.

UCAS and Next Step Predictions

For students applying to university this year, UCAS predicted grades will be the end of course predictions. These are the most realistic expected grades. Those students who will be applying for universities will be advised and supported by their tutors to check their potential outcomes against the entry requirements of their favoured universities and courses.
