Dear Parents and Carers,

The exam season is coming to an end so I would like to clarify how the final few weeks work to ensure students have as settled experience as possible.

The final GCSE exam is on **Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June**. It is important to note that the exam boards do have a 'Contingency Day' put aside on **Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June**. This means that students must be available to sit exams from the date of their first exam until Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2026, this is in case there are any issue with any exam paper so an alternative paper can be scheduled. It is unlikely this day will be required but students should keep this day available until they have finished their last exam.

Following their final exam, we will be collecting any donations of uniform, such as ties and blazers, revision guides and calculators to repurpose for other students if you have no further use for them. Alternatively, if you wish to drop these into reception in the weeks after the exams, any donations will be gratefully accepted.

The Year 11 Prom is by invitation only at **The Stanwick Hotel** on **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> June** for students who have been invited by their Senior Tutor for consistently meeting The Ferrers Framework expectations throughout year 11. We look forward to seeing those invited to celebrate their achievements throughout their time at The Ferrers School. We know that students will be very keen to attend, but invitations will not be fully secured until all exams have been completed by **Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2026**.

Exam results can be collected from the sixth form centre from **9am until 11am** on the morning of **Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August**. Senior leaders and members of the sixth form team will be on hand to offer advice on next steps when students receive their results. If your child is unable to collect their results in person, they will be able to access them on the Department for Education app after 11am. Alternatively, if they provide written consent for a named individual to collect them on their behalf and that individual brings identification with them, we can release results.
