Visit a farm | Make leaf rubbings | Make a sandwich | Visit a place of worship | Fly a kite | Make a paper boat and see if it floats
Post a letter | Search for butterflies outdoors | Make a treasure map | Have a teddy bears picnic

THINGS TO TRY BY THE END OF YEAR 1

Record different sounds and ask others to guess what they are | Make some biscuits | Put on a shadow puppet show
Borrow a book from a library | Discover what is in a pond | Look up at the stars on a clear night
Make a home for an insect or small creature | Create a comic strip | Roll down a hill and then make a daisy chain | Build a den

THINGS TO TRY BY THE END OF YEAR 2

Learn a poem off by heart | Take a trip to the seaside or walk alongside a river | Buy something and check your change
Make a mask | Bake a cake | Start a vegetable patch or pick blackberries | Get soaking wet in the rain | Go bird watching
