Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to remind you of the school's policy on chewing gum. Chewing gum is completely prohibited on the school grounds and any student caught chewing or with chewing gum on their person will receive a C4 and subsequent detention.

As a brand new school one of our responsibilities is to keep the site looking pristine for future generations of students; chewing gum is one of the quickest ways to make a school look run down and uncared for.

All students are aware of this rule and have previously been very compliant, however since we returned from the Easter holidays we have had multiple incidents with students chewing gum, including in lessons.

I would appreciate your support in reminding students of our stance on chewing gum and in ensuring that your child does not bring chewing gum into school. We want to support students in all aspects of their learning, friendships and fun, however we all have a responsibility to ensuring that WVA remains a pleasant and clean place for students both present and future.
